1. Assessment of existing conditions:

400 sq foot terrace in large Condo Building-- Southwest facing

- **A. Paving, materials, and furniture:** Existing paving—fencing to me replaced, no furniture currently.
- B. Plants: none currently
- C. Light and wind conditions: Southwest facing, very sunny, very exposed
- **D. Soil conditions/in ground vs planter/quality of existing soil**: Requires planters.
- E. Characteristics of site (building by-laws, weight, water use requirements, neighbor issues, soil: Will need to verify weights with Architect/Engineer to confirm loads can be tolerated with planters—paving and soil loads wet and dry. Should have roof surface inspected if new paving is installed to make sure in good condition. Flashing should be repaired.

Will require an irrigation system for linear planters and pots.

F. Access issues (access to water, elevator size & accessibility: Elevator access to 5th floor and then one flight of stairs from 5th to 6th floor within apartment. Access to water source on terrace.

2. Client preferences

- **A. General aesthetic/ inclination**: Space for entertaining large and small groups, area <u>for 'Green Egg BBQ'</u> lounging, dining, maintenance, highline inspired plantings,
- **B. Budget:** 20k to start, phased over time.
- **C. Plant preferences/colors (if any):** Low maintenance, likes highline, wild look, mix between evergreen and perennials, roses, orange and yellow perennials.
- **D. Degree of privacy, neatness:** Relatively private, views from common spaces from above



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3. Going Forward: Recommendations

Inspection and Permits: Recommendation to check with building regarding loads. If replacing paving, have inspection of roof membrane and repairs to flashing in advance.

Need to have sign-off on loads from Condo Board

Paver Recommendations: Natural Stone or Concrete Pavers

A. South Planters- Fiberglass linear planters L48" x 16" x 16" Climbing Roses mixed with Calamagrostis and Nepeta.

B. West Planters- Length 48 x W24" x H16" lined up at base of parapet, planted with Virgina Creeper vines to green fence, Boxwood mixed with Calamagrostis, Aesclepias, Helenium, Yarrow, Russian Sage, and Nepeta

C. Select 'Clear' Cedar fence horizontal slats (no knots): Fence along West and North Side of Terrace to screen Neighbors. With ½" gaps

C: Fiberglass planters: Length TBD x width 18" x Height TBD (height depends on bench backing detail)

D. Planters: L TBD x W10" x H12" mounted with fiberglass planters: Planted with English ivy to drape and soften brick wall.

E. Grouping of Three round Pots: West Elm or similar

Large round planter: 36" Diameter- Japanese Maple or Paperbark Birch planted with Autumn Moor Grass @base.

Medium round planter: 24"- Autumn Moor Grass mixed with rosemary, thyme, salvia.

Small Round Planter- 16" diameter

Herb garden: Rosemary, oregano, basil, lavender

F. Medium Round Planter 24" dia: placed at base of support for trellis. Planted with Wisteria to grow and soften trellis overhead.

G. Trellis: Either wood cantilevered from building, or off -the -shelf aluminum trellis to provide shade.


